VINC is a not for profit, SGA certified plant nursery that produces local indigenous flora for supply to government bodies, community groups, landscaping contractors and the public. Our objectives are to supply the local community with quality sustainably grown tubestock and to demonstrate the benefits of using indigenous plants through community awareness and education.

We collect seed from local sources to ensure that our plants are as genetically close as possible to the ones that would have naturally occurred here. Currently we are able to supply plants suitable for the inner, northern and north eastern/western suburbs of Melbourne, bounded loosely by Richmond, Ascot Vale, Keilor, Sunbury, Beveridge, Whittlesea, Eltham, Heidelberg, Balwyn and Camberwell.
